## BREAKING OPEN THE WORD

### THE SPIRIT IS WITH US

Last week it was worry. Today it is  
about loneliness. We know loneliness.  
We know what it feels like, for example,  
when someone close to us dies. Grief,  
sadness and loneliness can be palpable.  
In today's Gospel, John invites us again  
to draw closer to Jesus who addresses the  
loneliness which the disciples (and, at  
times, ourselves) can experience. When  
we feel God's apparent silence or absence,  
when we deal with death or tragedy, Jesus  
promises 'another Advocate'. This is the  
promise of his very Spirit that will remain  
with the disciples when he physically  
leaves them.

By the time John writes, this is already  
a reality and Jesus' spirit, the Advocate,  
the 'Spirit of Truth', is with them and  
'forever'. They will not be left orphaned  
as the Spirit accompanies them in every  
generation to experience his eternal and  
real, though non-physical, presence.  
But there is a second promise that Jesus  
makes. He will return as he offers an  
eschatological vision, an insight into  
the final days, in which the disciples  
will experience their communion and  
intimacy with God restored. They will  
discover a love that is eternal and carry  
them through those days of loneliness.

This is the promise that we need to  
hear, especially as we grapple with our  
experiences of loneliness brought on by  
grief of our beloved dead or the persistent  
loneliness of life that surrounds us. Jesus'  
Advocate, his Spirit, is with us.

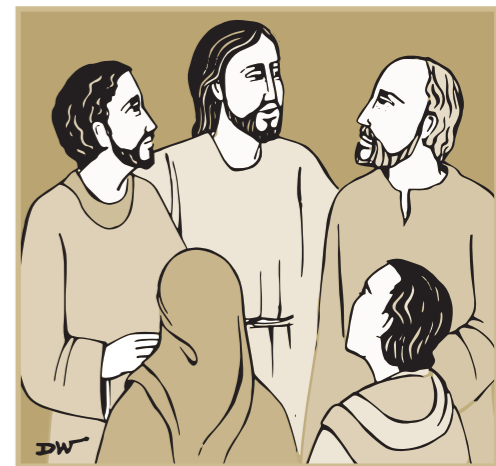

### St Patrick's Community Centre—Needing Volunteers

Volunteers for the St Patrick's Op Shops are needed.

There two Op Shops, both located in Fremantle: 101 High Street selling high-end fashion and upcycled clothing and 2-4 Market Street selling a mix of high-end fashion, upcycled clothing and bric-a-brac together with clothing and other items to assist people experiencing homelessness or at risk of homelessness.

All profits from these shops come back to St Pat's to assist those who are homeless or at risk of homelessness. St Pat's uses these funds to purchase food, medical equipment and other essential items.

Every new volunteer completes **four trial shifts** as part of a probation period. This helps us ensure the role is a good fit for both the volunteer and the team. After completing the trial shifts, new volunteers will either be formally accepted as a volunteer, or we mutually agree to part ways.

The commitment is weekly and the shifts tend to be 4 hours in length. You will need to be able to stand for this period. We offer full training so if you have never worked in a shop before, you will be supported by our lovely staff and volunteers to find your feet.

The shops are open 7 days and volunteers are mostly needed on the weekends, but there are limited times available during the week.
